

August 15 deadline to qualify for preseason pass sale NO EXCEPTIONS Our membership drive continues until August 15, 2022. *You MUST pay your dues by August 15, 2022* to be eligible to buy a season lift pass at the special Gray Wolf rate for Wolf Creek Ski Area. Find the application on the website at: www.graywolfskiclub.com Dues are \$15 per person. Membership is free for those 80 and older who have been a member for 3 previous years, but you must still complete a membership application each year. All season lift passes are sold by Wolf Creek Ski Area (WCSA). They will use the August 15th Gray Wolf Ski Club membership list to verify discounts on season lift passes and the email address you provided with your Gray Wolf Ski Club membership to send WCSA ski contract/waiver link

Meet your Board Members!

President: Chris Johnson. The president presides over meetings of the board officers as well as meetings of the entire club. As a member of all standing committees, he/she helps to facilitate the actions of those committees.

Vice President: Sheila Manzanares. The Vice President position is responsible for securing the weekly happy hour locations and also working with local businesses to negotiate annual Gray Wolf membership discounts.

Secretary: Becky Gerze. The Secretary takes notes from the meetings, sends them out to the board, then after any changes, prints a hard copy and file a copy in the Gray Wolf file.

Treasurer: Stacey Mergens. Treasurers responsibilities include, but are not limited to, accurately recording all income and expense items, monitoring the PO Box, ordering Name tags and distributing them to members who purchased them, and being available for reimbursement for club related expenses. Payment of recurring expenses, PO Box, Storage unit, insurance, and Web support. Filing required State forms, as related to club activities.

Publications Editor: Laura Vanoni. The Publications Editor is responsible for creating and editing the Quarterly newsletters.

Membership Coordinator: Cynthia Riski. The Membership Coordinator maintains Gray Wolf Ski Club membership list (new/renewal) and submits to Wolf Creek Ski area for club discounted season pass, maintains Gray Wolf ski club website, maintains Gray Wolf ski club email broadcast group list, sends email broadcast messages and responds to email queries from membership

Programs Director: Lassie Olin. The Program Chair is responsible for securing the venue for the Christmas Party, Annual Meeting, and the brats in August for the beginning of the ski season, as well as securing all paper products, cutlery, etc for all functions. The position also secures the beer, wine, tea, water. In charge of setting up, decorations, and take-down and cleanup of all functions

President Emeritus: Ron Chacey. Ron has been on the Board in various positions for over 20 years. After giving up the President's seat, the Board, as a token of appreciation for his years of service, appointed Ron President Emeritus for life. Ron provides knowledge of historical precedents and bylaws. He attends the board meetings, offers advice, and volunteers, but does not have a vote.

East Side Representative: Paul Midgley

Ski Area Liaison: Simon Fuger. The ski area liaison interfaces with the owners and management on all sanctioned Gray Wolves activities that may occur throughout the year at the Ski Area. This includes communicating dates, times and agreeing to specific lunch items on the menu. No Gray Wolf event is held at the Ski area without the permission of management. In addition any concerns about Gray Wolf behavior or social activities is communicated through the ski area liaison conversely any Gray Wolf concerns about the ski area is communicated through liaison to the ski area. At the beginning and the end of the ski season the liaison meets with the ski area management to review upcoming functions or to debrief at the end of the season.
